Dear Jardine Academy Community,

Our school is committed to protecting the health of our students, teachers, and staff. To protect our community and comply with the Department of Education regulations, The Jardine Academy tested its drinking water for lead.

Given technical guidance developed by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, we completed a plumbing profile for our school; we identified and tested all drinking water outlets and food preparation outlets. Of the 31 samples taken, 30 met the standards established by the US Environmental Protection Agency for lead in drinking water (15ug/l [ppb]).

One water fountain (Main Street Water Fountain) tested above the 15ug/l action level for lead. As soon as the results were received, the outlet was disconnected. This water source will either be replaced or remain disconnected. Please be assured that we have taken and will continue to take all necessary actions to ensure that the water quality throughout our facilities is safe for all.
